getting to the chateau

The Castle of Chenonceau is located in the Touraine region, in Chenonceaux, 214km from Paris, 34km from Tours.

2 hours via the A10 motorway (Blois or Amboise exits)

1hr via TGV (High-Speed Train) from Paris. Paris-Montparnasse/St-Pierre-des-Corps (Tours)

1hr40 by TGV (High-Speed Train) from Roissy Paris-Aéroport Roissy-CDG/St-Pierre-des-Corps

25minutes by TER (Regional Train) from Tours. Tours/Chenonceaux
